

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Your admission to UC Santa Cruz for the fall quarter 2011 is provisional subject to the conditions listed below. **It is important that you read these carefully because your admission will be withdrawn if you do not fulfill these conditions.**

1. Meet all requirements needed for transfer eligibility to the University of California.
2. Complete the course work you reported as “in-progress” or “planned” with minimum grades of C (2.0).

Notify our office, either by e-mail or by letter, of any changes to your program of study, including attendance at an institution different from that listed on your application, as these changes may affect your admission.

3. Maintain good standing at your last school.

A student is in good standing if the grade point average is at least 2.0 and the official transcript does not indicate dismissal, probation, or other restrictions. A student who has outstanding financial obligations to another institution is not considered to be in good standing.

4. Have all official transcripts, including final high school transcript, sent to our office by July 15, 2011.

An official transcript is one that we receive in the institution’s sealed envelope with appropriate identifying information and authorizing signature. Advanced Placement (AP) examination results should be sent directly to our office from the AP Program of the College Board. International Baccalaureate (IB) examination results should be sent directly to our office from the International Baccalaureate Organization.
