

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Your admission to UC Santa Cruz for the fall quarter 2009 is provisional subject to the conditions listed below. **It is important that you read these carefully because your admission will be withdrawn if you do not fulfill these conditions.**

1. Earn a level of academic achievement in your fall and spring courses consistent with your previous course work, with no grade lower than a C.

If you have already earned a grade of D or F in your senior year (fall or spring), you have not met these conditions of admission.

2. Complete the course work listed on your application and graduate from high school.

Notify our office, either by e-mail or by letter, of any changes to your program of study, including attendance at a school different from that listed on your application, as these changes may affect your admission.

3. Complete the official examination pattern required by the University of California.

UC requires all students to complete the SAT-R or the ACT with combined English and Writing AND two SAT-S exams in two different subject areas. Subject areas include: English, Mathematics (only level-2 is acceptable), Science, History & Social Studies, and Languages.

4. Submit all official transcripts (final high school and all collegiate records) and official test scores to our office by July 15, 2009.

An official transcript is one that we receive directly from the institution in a sealed envelope with appropriate identifying information and authorized signature. If you received a GED or CHSPE, an official copy of the results is required. In addition to the required examination scores, Advanced Placement (AP) exam results should be submitted to our office from the College Board and International Baccalaureate (IB) exam results submitted from the International Baccalaureate Organization.
