

COMPUTER SCIENCE (FIRST YEARS & TRANSFERS)

If you are interested in computer science you must select the major as your first choice on the UC Application. You are encouraged to have a solid background in advanced high school or college mathematics. If you were not selected for computer science, you may be reviewed for admission to an alternate major if you had one on the application. Whether you are a first year or a transfer, you will not be able to switch to computer science after you've enrolled at UCSC.



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

INTERNATIONAL FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS

In addition to qualifying for UC via the process described above, you must meet the nonresident GPA of 3.40 or higher, and meet other requirements specific to your home country. UC Santa Cruz has an English **Proficiency Requirement.**





MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

 Complete at least 60 semester units or 90 quarter units of UCtransferable coursework.

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 Complete a UC-transferable 7-course pattern with minimum C (2.00) grades. Each course must be at least 3 semester units/4 quarter units.

3.00+ grade-point average (GPA) in "a-g" courses with no grade lower than a C.

As an out-of-state applicant, you will need to meet the same requirements as a California-resident student, and you must meet the nonresident GPA of 3.40 or higher.

TRANSFER **ADMISSION**

UC Santa Cruz welcomes transfer students from community colleges and from other four year institutions. Junior-level transfer students from California community colleges receive priority admission, but lower-division applicants and second baccalaureate applicants will be considered, depending on the strength of the application and capacity during that term.

- Earn a 2.40 overall UC **GPA. Higher GPAs are more** competitive.
- Complete required lowerdivision courses with the required grades/GPA for the intended major.
