The Eleanor C. Wilkerson Scholarship

As a Compton High School graduate, if you enroll at UC Santa Cruz and qualify for financial aid, you are automatically entered into consideration for the Eleanor C. Wilkerson Scholarship. The scholarship typically awards \$1,000 to \$2,000, reducing the amount you need to cover through work or loans.

How To Apply

- 1. Complete the UC Application for undergraduate admissions and scholarships between August 1st and December 2nd for the following year admission—make sure to select UC Santa Cruz. admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/apply-now
- 2. Complete a financial aid application (FAFSA or CADAA) by the March 2nd deadline.
- 3. After you receive your acceptance, contact the UC Santa Cruz Financial Aid and Scholarship Office to get an estimate of your financial aid—including the Eleanor C. Wilkerson Scholarship.
